

Accommodations for SACP 2023 Annual Meeting

The SACP has arranged for group rates at two local hotels. In each case, you must indicate that you are part of the SACP in order to receive the group rate.

This hotel is located very near Golden Gate Park and is about a 20-minute walk from the conference location.

We have ten rooms reserved at this hotel (eight with 1 king-sized bed, two with 2 double beds), at a rate of \$249 per night. This rate includes free breakfast, free wi-fi, and free bottled water. Parking is available across the street for \$25 per day.

The conference is approximately 30 minutes from this hotel by foot.

Room options in this hotel include:

- Deluxe Queen (one bed): \$597.60 per night
- Deluxe Double (two beds): \$705.60 per night
- Deluxe Queen with bay windows: \$669.60 per night
- Suite (two queen beds in separate rooms): \$795.60 per night

Additionally, we have nine rooms available in apartments on the campus of the University of San Francisco (the conference venue). These rooms include free wifi and free parking, and each unit includes a kitchen. These rooms are only available for the dates of the conference (arriving November 8, departing November 12). Participants staying in these rooms will pay the SACP directly.

Room options in the on-campus apartments include:

- 3-bedroom units: \$250 per night. (You are welcome to apply as an individual or as a group. These units could house more than 3 people, if you are comfortable with such an arrangement, but it will be your responsibility to arrange such a situation.)
- 1-bedroom unit: \$150 per night. (Only one of these is available.)
- 1-bedroom unit, upgraded: \$200 per night. (Only one of these is available.)

Preference for these rooms will be given to students, part-time faculty, and retired faculty. If you are a member of one of these groups, please let us know by **September 1**; after that time, we'll make them available to all participants on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Suggestions for Accommodations that have not been arranged by the SACP:

Metro Hotel

- 25-minute walk to conference location
- 11/8-11/12 dates are currently available
- small boutique hotel (23 rooms total available, but not at block rates)
- \$240/night for standard queen
- \$206/night for room with double bed
- \$291/night for room with 2 deluxe double beds
- \$248/night for room with 2 twin beds

Best Western Red Coach Inn

- \$120/night (very affordable)
- 43-minute walk to campus, but an easy and direct bus ride
- The downside: this is not the most aesthetically pleasing area.
